Sheriff Hutton Rd Bridge approach – Vehicle Activated Sign

I am writing to inform you that work to install a new vehicle activated sign on Sheriff Hutton Road will take place over the first two Mondays in February.

The works breakdown as follows:

Monday 6th February 2017: New sign post installed.

Monday 13th February 2017: Sign installed and commissioned.

Traffic management in the form of temporary traffic signals will be provided to keep the workforce safe for the duration of the works. These will be removed at the end of each working day.

The work will not directly affect all local residents, but, as with any highway scheme, there is likely to be some minor inconvenience at times. However, we would like to assure you, that everything reasonably possible will be done to keep this to a minimum. Access to all properties will be available throughout the duration of the works.

The works are to be carried out by SWARCO, who will be responsible for site safety and maintaining access. Should you wish to contact the council regarding the works please contact me using the details at the top of this letter.
