

On Tuesday 3rd January 2017 at 2pm in the Village Hall

Present: Cllrs Chambers and Mrs J Smith and the clerk

Declarations of personal interest in any item on the Agenda – None

Maintenance

The quote for 2017 would include 30 visits with a total of £1,950.00 which equates to £65 per visit. As the contractor maintains the grounds to a high standard, the committee recommend acceptance of the quote.

Soil Removal.

The grave diggers fees for the removal of the soil for each grave is £60.00 the Committee recommend that this cost is passed to the funeral directors as part of the funeral costs rather than the PC providing a skip and manpower to remove the excess soil twice a year.

Fee Increase

The committee discussed the fee situation and felt that, in order to maintain the high standard of care, they would recommend the fees should be increased by 5% as appendix 3

Amended Rules

The committee recommend that, now there are two children in the cemetery, the addition of Rule 7 should be included to read:-

“There is a dedicated children’s section in the cemetery to the right of the entrance at the top. The exact location can be confirmed by the Clerk”

Removal of Unacceptable Items
